SERMON OUTLINE

JOY IN HEAVEN

I. The 24 elders / four living creatures (4).

I.1 They honored the Lord for creating all things (Revelation 4:10-11).

I.2 They honored the Lord by singing praises to the Lamb who was worthy to open the scroll, thus declaring His right to redeem the earth from its bondage to corruption (Revelation 5:8-9).

I.3 They celebrated the arrival of that great multitude of saints whose robes had been washed white in the blood of the Lamb (Revelation 7:11-12).

I.4 When the seventh trumpet sounded, they fell on their faces and worshipped again for the glorious announcement (Revelation 11:15-18).

I.5 And now once more, when the fall of Babylon is recalled and the nearness of Christ's great victory is considered, they add their "Amen! Hallelujah!" (Revelation 19:4-6).

II. Hallelujah (1, 3, 4, 6).

II.1 This passage is like a hymn.

II.2 These are the four times "hallelujah" appears in the NT. Hallelujah: A traditional, liturgical exclamation of joy and praise. 24 Psalms begin with or begin and finish with this declaration. "Hallelujah" is a Hebrew word which means, "Praise be to God" / "Praise the Lord" (Psalm 104-106). Why is the Lord to be praised?

II.2.1 Salvation: God's deliverance of His people from their enemies (1).

II.2.2 Justice: God's pouring out of just wrath and permanent destruction of man's rebellion (2-3).

II.2.3 Sovereignty: All fall and worship God (6). "Almighty" is used 9 times in Revelation as a title for God.

II.2.4 Relationship: God's communion with His people (7).

II.3 Handel's Hallelujah chorus was inspired by this text.
