## SERMON OUTLINE

### I. Author and Date.

- I.1 The author's name does not appear.
- I.2 John and James (older brother / **Acts 12:2**) were known as **“the sons of Zebedee”** (**Mt. 10:2-4**); Jesus also gave them the name **“Sons of Thunder”** / Aramaic **“Boanerges”** (**Mk. 3:17**).

### II. Background and setting.

- II.1 John provides a large amount of unique material not recorded in the synoptic Gospels (**Matthew, Mark, & Luke**).
- II.2 John often supplies complementary material that helps with understanding the synoptics.
- II.3 Although aware of the synoptics when writing, John's Gospel is more theological than historical narrative (**John 3:13-17**), including a significant amount on God, the Holy Spirit (**John 14:16-17, 26; 16:7-14**).
- II.4 Like Luke (**Luke 1:1-4; Acts 1:1-8**), John declares his purpose in writing the Gospel (**John 20:30-31**).
  - II.4.1 Evangelistic (**“believe”** occurs approximately 100-times).
  - II.4.2 Apologetic (providing reasons in accordance with **John 1:12**)
  - II.4.3 Divine Messiah. There are also seven emphatic **“I Am”** statements which identify Jesus Christ as God, the “Mashiach, or Anointed One” (**John 6:35, 8:12, 10:7, 9, 11, 14; 11:25, 14:6, 15:1, 5**).
